Accommodation

Jersey provides a range of accommodation from basic family run Guest Houses to mid range hotels catering for families and large groups to top class five Star luxury and boutique hotels together with plenty of self catering apartments and chalets and even camping.

In developing an information pack for potential participants of the Summer camp 2012 we would identify a number different Guest house, Hotels and self catering units that :-

- provide a range of standard of accommodation
- are in various locations around the island. ie in Town, on the Coast and inland.
- suit the needs and hopefully the budgets of everyone from young singles to families.

We also recognise that these are difficult financial times and accommodation in Jersey can seem expensive. We wouldn't want anyone to miss the opportunity to come to the summer camp 2012 in Jersey due to concerns over the cost of accommodation. If required local club members would endeavour to accommodate people within their own homes if necessary.

At this stage we haven't established which accommodation we would include within the our information pack but to provide you an indication of costs and standards available we have listed below examples of the various types of accommodation with costs based on July 2011 prices.

These are only indicative prices and we would aim to gain group and early booking discounts where ever possible.

Before we include accommodation within our information pack we will endeavour to inspect each of the properties and speak to the proprietors to ensure that the participants of the summer camp get the best possible accommodation.

Guesthouse and small budget hotel.

There are numerous small guest houses and small hotels in Jersey in a variety of locations across the island. These tend to be family run properties and can range from someone letting out a spare room with shared bathrooms to a 20 roomed small hotel with ensuite accommodation.

We have detailed below a list of some the accommodation available and an indication of the pricing. Guest house accommodation tends to be let on a per person bed and breakfast basis. The proposed

dates for the summer camp is in the high season so we may see a premium on the prices. In a number of cases young children, when sharing the rooms with the parents will stay free or at a reduced rate.

Hotels

There are a great variety of hotels in terms of style, location, standard and price. From Five Star exclusive hotels like the Grand Spar hotel providing luxury accommodation at £250 per room per night to small comfortable two star hotels at £80/90 per room per night or £40/£50 per person per night bed and breakfast.

A number of the larger higher star hotels will offer good discounts from their standard room rates for early booking, group bookings and for stays of greater than 5 night. This in some cases can make them more economical than the lower star accommodation.

Although there is a large number of self catering apartment and cottages in Jersey they are very popular and get booked up very early in the season, in some case years in advance. We have provide below a few example of a cross section of availability.

Beaustite apartments

For example you can hire L'Etacquerel Fort which sleeps up to 30 people for c £1120 per week. That only £5.33 per person per night.
